

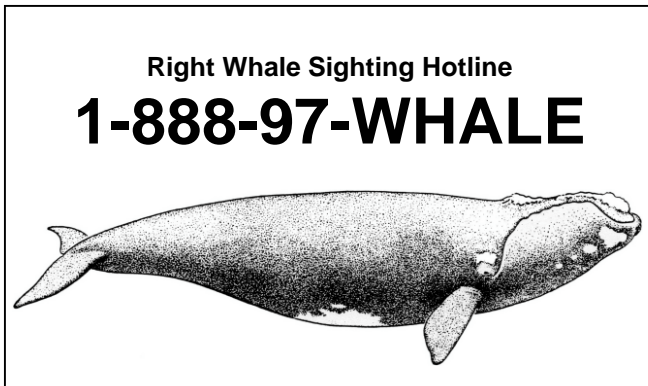
## License Plate Supports Right Whales

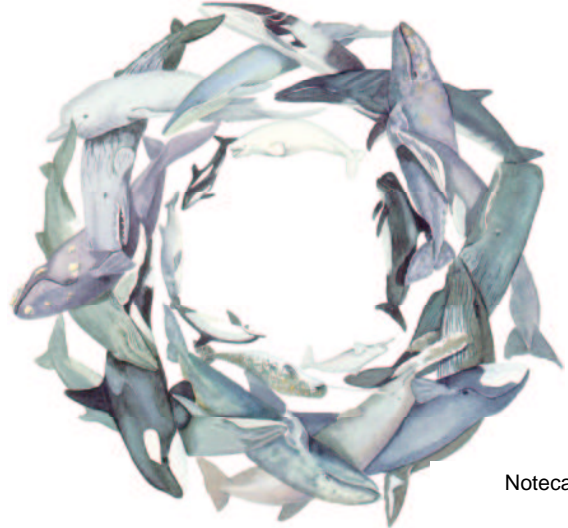


## Purchase a Right Whale Catalog

A right whale catalog is maintained by the New England Aquarium. It contains over 400 right whales, including those who are confirmed and presumed dead. For each whale, six of the best photos and a drawn composite are included. The catalog is updated every two to three years and costs \$20.
